



## **Transport safety regulations for seller of precious metals**

1. Pack the coins and/or ingots so well that they can not damage each other in the package during transportation. So i.a. in the shipment of heavy silver coins the size of e.g. 10 ounces or 1 kg to package each coin in bubble wrap.
2. Place the packed coins / ingots in a box which each length has a minimum of 5 cm.
3. Please fill in cavities in the package with paper or plastic filling material.
4. A package may have a gross maximum weight of 15 kg and a maximum value of 10,000 EURO. If the weight is higher and/or the purchase value is higher, please divide the coins / bars so that they keep the maximum values and write down which coins / ingots are in which package.
5. Please contact us so that we can provide you additional shipping labels if the number of packages is not sufficient regarding of the maximum values
6. After closing the package, please glue it with package adhesive tape.
7. Please stick the shipping label on the package, which you will receive from us or the shipping company by email.
8. DO NOT put any further information on the package that in any way indicates the content!
9. If the pickup is arranged by UPS, please make sure that the parcel is scanned by the deliverer in your presence (clear beeping from the scanning device)! This is important to prove the pickup!
10. If the shipping is agreed with DHL, please use the next post office. You will receive a printed receipt, which you have to keep safely until we confirm the receipt of the shipment!

**Please note that failure to comply with the transport safety regulations will result that our transport insurance is not longer liable and transportation will be at your own risk.**
